

This information is being sent to you to help make the registration process as informative as possible. We recommend that you share this information with other families. In addition, after completing your registration please keep a completed copy for your records. All registrations must be completed on the NAARVA website at www.naarva.com.

All registrations must be completed no later than, May 31, 2025.

<u>Acceptable forms of payment</u>: Payment must be made in full online using the NAARVA Member Portal. Please do not send money orders or cash. All returned checks will be assessed a fee of a \$75.00 administrative fee above the registration fee.

Cancellation Policy: All cancellations must adhere to the following criteria:

- 1. Must be requested:
 - a. Email to <u>naarva.rvrally@gmail.com</u> must be dated no later than <u>May 31,</u> <u>2025.</u> or
 - b. Mail to 961 Roberts Branch Pkwy, Ste 106-240, Columbia, SC 29203 must be postmarked no later than May 31, 2025.
- 2. <u>All</u> approved cancellations will have a \$75.00 administrative fee deducted. Any meal/site/tour cost that cannot be cancelled will also be deducted. <u>There will not be any full cancellation</u> refunds after May 9, 2025.

Parking:

- 1. <u>Sites</u>: We are limited to 500 reservations. All sites are 30–50-amp electric, water connection with 1 sewer dump included in your registration fee. Additional sewer dumps are \$50 paid by you. Registrants will be parked together based on chapter affiliation, with first consideration made for the size of your Recreational Vehicle and or handicap site request. If you wish to be parked with another registrant, you must arrive together.
- 2. <u>Daily/Late Arrival</u>: RV's will be parked from Sunday, July 13, 2025, to Wednesday, July 16, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. A phone number for the Administrative Officer of the Day will be provided closer to the arrival date for members arriving after 4:00 PM.
- 3. Early Bird Arrival: If you wish to arrive Friday July 11, or Saturday July 12, Early Bird arrival is available for \$45 per night.

4. Handicap Parking:

There are sites that have been designated within the park that are close to the Agricultural Building for planned rally activities for those requiring handicapped parking.
