This information is being sent to you to help make the registration process as informative as possible. **All registrations must be postmarked no later than June 15, 2023.** Please do not mail any registrations after June 15, 2023. Registrations dated/postmarked after June 15, 2023 will not be processed as pre-registration, they will be processed as on-site gate registration and charged a \$50.00 fee.

**Acceptable forms of payment:** Payment must be made in full by check, money order or PayPal. Please do not send cash. All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$50.00 and a \$25.00 administrative fee above the registration fee.

**On-site Gate registration:** These registrants will be charged an additional \$50.00 fee above the regular registration fee. Cash or Money Order will be the acceptable method of payment for on-site gate registration.

**Cancellation Policy:** All cancellations must adhere to the following criteria:

1. Must be requested in writing:
  - a. Email to [naarva.rvally@gmail.com](mailto:naarva.rvally@gmail.com), must be dated no later than June 15, 2023.
  - b. Send by U.S. Mail to P.O. Box 220246, Charlotte, NC 28222, must be dated/postmarked no later than June 15, 2023.
2. **All** approved cancellations will have a \$50.00 administrative fee deducted. Any meal/site/tour cost that cannot be cancelled will also be deducted. **There will not be any full cancellation refunds after June 15, 2023.**

### **Parking:**

1. **Sites:** We are limited to 250 reservations. All sites are full hook-ups with 30-50 amp electric, water and sewer connections. Our first consideration must be made for the size of your Recreational Vehicle and or handicap site request.
2. **Daily/Late Arrival:** RV's will be parked from Sunday, July 23, 2023, to Thursday, July 27, from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. Only EMERGENCY PARKING will be done after 6:00 pm. A phone number for The Administrative Officer of the Day will be published in a Constant Contact announcement closer to the rally date. You will not be able to park without a member of the NAARVA parking team.
3. **Early Bird Arrival:** If you wish to arrive between Tuesday, July 18, 2023, through Saturday, July 22, 2023, early bird arrival is available for \$45 per night.
4. **Handicap Parking:**

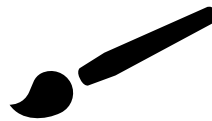
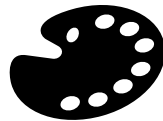
