IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Recent upgrades have been made to the NAARVA website with the new addition of an interactive membership portal. NARVA Chaplain's Corner... What Grade Do You Deserve



Since birth, we have been indoctrinated into the world's educational grading system, from highest to lowest: A, B, C, D, and F. We incorporated this system as a guide to evaluate our performance. So, it is not indicative to think our God uses this same system to grade the performance of His people.

Paul warns us that we all are sinners and fall short of the glory of God, Romans 3:23. All of us deserve His wrath and punishment. But, God, in His infinite grace and mercy, has provided a way that His wrath can be appeased and we can be reconciled to Him. It is through the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ as the payment for our sins. It is through faith in Jesus Christ as God's perfect sacrifice that we can be reconciled to God.

Paul calls this a free gift that brings salvation from death, rescuing us from the wrath of God in judgment on sin. Christ is our propitiation. He satisfied the wrath of God against our sins, Romans 5:15-18, John 14:6, 1 John 2:2.

When we feel we need to do something to be worthy, we must remember that God has already given us a way. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me," John 14:6. There is no other propitiation or sacrifice that can be made. When we turn our lives over to Christ, we receive;

A. "Acceptance" for accepting the calling of Jesus Christ. Jesus often called salvation and the subsequent indwelling of the Holy Spirit a free gift, John 5:15, 16, 18.

B. "Baptism," John the Baptist said, "I indeed baptized you with water unto repentance, but he that cometh

after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear; he shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire." Matthew 3:11.

C. "Christ-like," we become a new creature. Our minds and hearts have been reshaped and reconditioned not to follow the world continually, but now we follow after Christ, 2 Corinthians 5:17.

D. "Discipleship," we walk and follow with Christ; we become one of His disciples. We are His students, and He is the master teacher. Jesus was quite explicit about the cost of following Him. Discipleship requires a committed life, Matthew 16:24.

F. "Finish," we finished the race, fought a good fight, and most importantly, we kept the faith, 1 Timothy 6:12, 2 Timothy 4:7.


