2024 CENTRAL REGION RALLY GENERAL INFORMATION

Please retain these rally information pages for future reference.

This information is being sent to help make the registration process as informative as possible. You may duplicate the Registration Form prior to completing it and share with other families. The documents can be downloaded from the Central Region webpage on the NAARVA website at WWW.NAARVA.COM.

Do not mail registration forms after **May 3, 2024**, as registrations postmarked after **May 3, 2024**, will be charged a late fee of \$50.00. On-site gate registrations will be charged an additional \$50.00 fee above and beyond the regular registration fee with cash, cashier check, money order or payment by Zelle being the only acceptable methods of payment.

Acceptable forms of payment: Payment must be made in full by personal, company check or money order, payable to NAARVA–Central Region, or by Zelle (naarvacentralregion@yahoo.com). Do not send cash. All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$30.00 and a \$15.00 administrative fee above and beyond the registration fee. Payment after **May 3, 2024**, must be paid in full by cashier check, money order or Zelle. If Rally Registration payment is made via Zelle, a completed registration form will still need to be mailed to allow accurate registration for each member attending.

Parking: RVs will be parked starting Sunday, June 16th from **8:00 AM to 6:00 PM** On Monday, June 17th, and Wednesday June 19th, parking is scheduled 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Anyone arriving after the parking windows close must call Vince Gorman, Parking Chairperson at 216-385-5452. No one will be parked after 8:00 PM. **Please do not attempt to park yourself.**

Chapters and groups that want to park together **must** send in their registration forms together in the same envelope. For the informal groups that want to park together please assign your group a unique name (i.e., Traveling Wonders, etc.) on your registration form. Every attempt will be made to have your group parked together, but it is NOT guaranteed (depending on the size of the group).

Early Bird Arrival Parking: We ask anyone arriving before June 15th to designate the arrival date on your registration form so you can park in your assigned rally site. If you plan to arrive before June 15th, use this link to make your reservation www.camp.exploremoreil.com for dates prior to June 15th only.

Handicap Parking: The Campground does NOT have designated handicapped parking.

Consider renting a golf cart or bring your own personal transportation (medical scooter) as vehicle parking is limited around various Complex buildings.

All attendees will receive their site assignment via email. Please indicate on your Registration form your arrival date and remember to check your email for Constant Contact messages.

Campsites: One hundred Thirty-Five (135) full 50-amp hook-up sites have been reserved for the rally June 15-23, 2024. All sites are back-in.

Buildings: Activities will be held at the Main Event Center. Other facilities we will use include the Pavilion (for the Men's Event) and the Shooting Range.

Planned Events

Auction: Each chapter/group is asked to furnish **two (2) gift items valued at \$25 or more for each gift.** Items should be in a gift bag or wrapped in paper. Members at Large and individuals are also asked to donate items. **Club Presidents or a Club Representative should bring gifts to the Event Center upon registration.** The Auction will take place on Saturday, June 22nd from 12:30 to 2:30 PM.

Bean Bag Baseball and Corn Hole Tournaments: Each chapter or group will be asked to participate as a team in the Bean Bag tournament. Practice rounds for Bean Bag Baseball will be held at a Club's request. The Final Competition will take place on Thursday, June 20th. Each team will need to have a minimum of 7 people. Let your Chapter President or group leader know whether you wish to be part of the team. Until then, get your "pitching arm" warmed up. The Corn Hole Tournament will be played with teams of 2 people on Thursday, June 20th. Sign-up sheets will be at the Registration Desk.

Cake Walk and Ice Cream Social: Each Chapter is asked to furnish two cakes or sealed baked goods. Bring your cakes to the Event Center on Friday, June 21st no earlier than 3:30 PM. Be sure to stay and enjoy the cake walk which starts at 4:00 PM. (Have your ice cream go along with your cake.)

Card Bingo: Come enjoy this exciting and fast paced game on Tuesday night, June 18th, beginning at 5:30 PM. There will be a \$.25 fee collected for each game.

Meal: The evening dinner will be held Thursday, June 20th 6:00 to 9:00 PM. (We have adjusted the time and day from past rallies.)

Meet & Greet: Our Meet & Greet will be held Monday, June 17th, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM. Light refreshments will be served.

Members will leave Sparta at 8:00 AM and arrive in St. Louis at approximately 9:30 AM. Attendees will leave the Arch at 1:30 PM, arriving back in Sparta around 3:00 PM. This tour will include a Tramride to the top of the Arch, viewing of a special documentary regarding the Arch, and a 1 hour narrated boat cruise down the Mississippi River viewing the surrounding area. Members will also receive a box lunch which can be enjoyed while on the cruise (complete enclosed Lunch Order Form and send in with Registration Form). World Shooting and Recreational Complex

The World Shooting and Recreational Complex is in scenic Southern Illinois and located at 1 Main Event Lane, Sparta, IL 62286. The complex encompasses 1,600 acres and offers camping, fishing, and a variety of sport shooting disciplines, including skeet, rifle, pistol, clay and trapshooting. The Central Region will be in the North Loop which has Premium campsites, each equipped with 50 amp and full hook-up service. All sites are back-in for units up to 60 feet long. Fishing is allowed sunrise to sunset on several lakes within the Complex. An Illinois fishing license is required which can be purchased at a Walmart in Illinois. White Oak Golf Course is located nearby, as well as Schneidewind Barn Museum.

Each camper is permitted space for one camper unit and one additional vehicle. Campers are asked to be respectful of their neighbors when running generators.

Pets are allowed only in the immediate vicinity of your camper and must be on a leash. No dogs, cats, or other pets, except for Service Animals shall be permitted in the Event Center. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their animal and placing the waste in a trash receptacle.

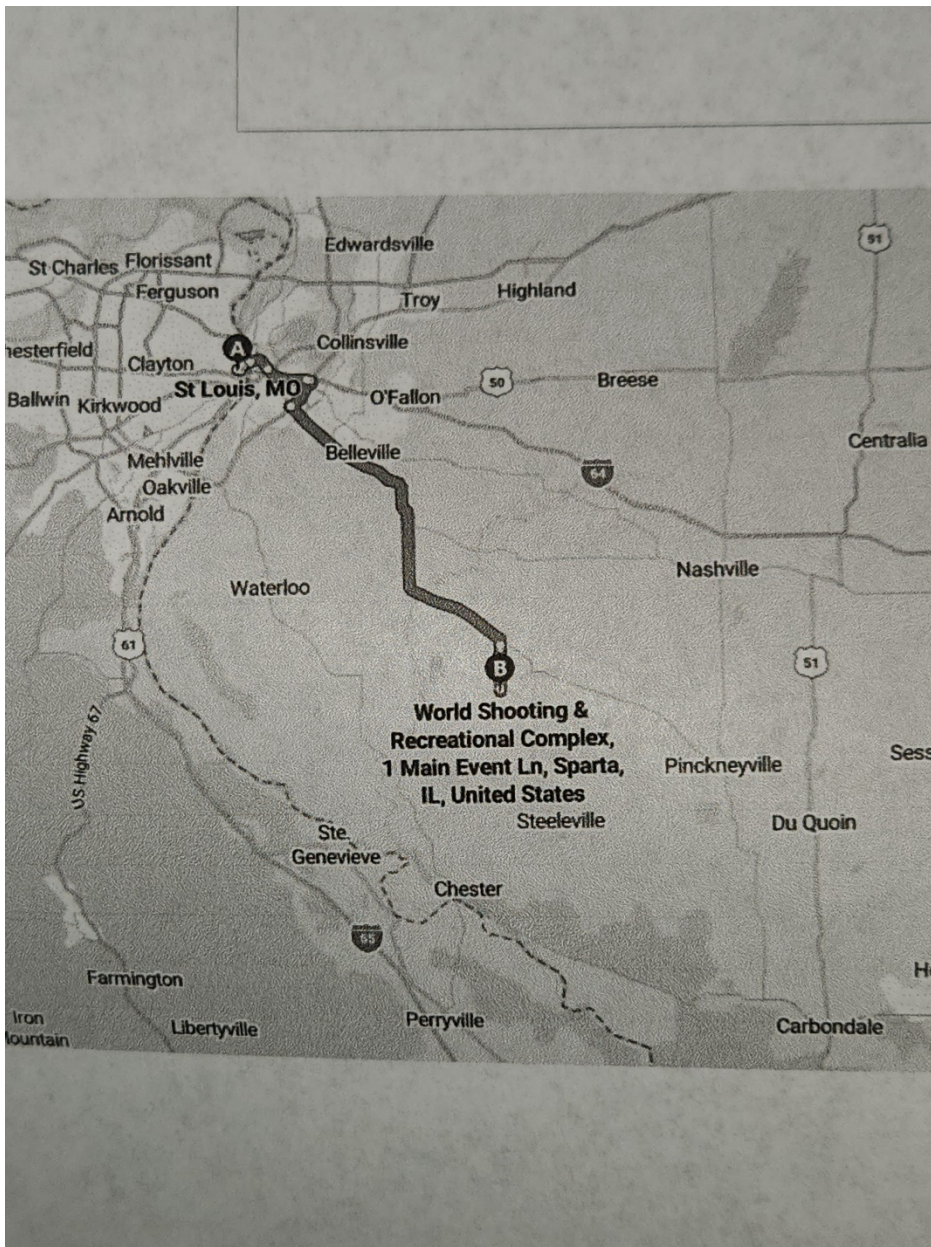
Directions to the World Shooting and Recreational Complex
